Take Home Equipment Guide

Basic Camping

K-4 Tents (Kelty 4-man tent)

Includes:

- 1 tent bag
- 1 pole bag
- 1 peg bag
- 2 sets of poles
- 1 ground cloth (clear)
- 1 tent
- 1 rain fly
- 8 pegs

(Set-up tent on a clear and dry day)

1. Hang clear plastic ground cloth and grey rain fly to dry and air out.
2. Set-up tent without ground cloth or rain fly.
3. Let tent dry and air out.
4. Sweep floor of the tent clean.
5. Brake down tent.
6. Lay out ground cloth, place tent on top of ground cloth, then place rain fly on top
7. Fold into thirds
8. Place pegs in short peg bag then place pole in long pole bag.
9. Place poles and pegs on top of tent and role-up and place in bag.
10. Return to quartermaster next meeting.

Red Coolers

1. Remove **ALL** food from cooler
2. Wash out cooler with soap and water
3. Let dry
4. Return **EMPTY** next meeting to quartermaster

Blue Bins

1. Remove perishable food, leave dry goods for next month
2. If any odor, wash with soap and water then let dry
3. Return to quartermaster the next meeting

Wash Bins

1. Wash with soap and water
2. Let dry
3. Return to quartermaster next meeting

Stove

1. Open stove and lift grate
2. Use a damp sponge to wipe away any dirt from around the burners
(do not place in water)
3. Return to quartermaster next meeting

Red Water Jug

1. Unscrew top
2. Wash with soap and water
3. Let dry
4. Return next meeting to quartermaster

Roll Table

1. Remove aluminum roll top from bag
2. Wash top and bottom of the table top
3. Let dry and pack back in bag
4. Return next meeting to quartermaster

Dining Fly

1. Open bag and remove green fly
2. Hang and let dry
3. Brush the dirt off
4. Role up fly and place in bag
5. Return next meeting to quartermaster

Cook Kit (Pot and Pan Set)

1. Remove ALL pots and pans
2. Scrub with soap and water, steel wool if necessary
3. Let dry
4. Return next meeting to quartermaster

Chief Kit (Utensil Set)

1. Unroll set
2. Wash ALL utensils by hand in soap and water
3. Let dry
4. Return next meeting to quartermaster

Blue Water Jug

1. Unscrew top
2. Rinse clean DO NOT use soap
3. Let dry
4. Return next meeting to quartermaster

Backpack Camping

BP-Stoves

1. Remove from bag
2. Wash pot with soap and water
3. Use a damp cloth to wipe burner clean (DO NOT place in water)
4. Let dry
5. Return next meeting to quartermaster

BP-Tent

(Set-up tent on a clear and dry day)

1. Hang clear plastic ground cloth and grey rain fly to dry and air out.
2. Set-up tent without ground cloth or rain fly.
3. Let tent dry and air out.
4. Sweep floor of the tent clean.
5. Brake down tent.
6. Lay out ground cloth, place tent on top of ground cloth, then place rain fly on top
7. Place pegs in short peg bag then place pole in long pole bag.
8. Place poles and pegs on top of tent and role-up and place in bag.
9. Return to quartermaster next meeting.

Water Bag

1. Rinse with water
2. Let dry
3. Return next meeting to quartermaster

Water Filters

1. Clean the outside of pump with water and soap

2. Unscrew the water filter
3. Clean the inside with tap water (no soap!!!)
4. Reassemble, pump some fresh tap water thru
5. Take it apart again and let air dry before reassemble
6. Return next meeting to quartermaster
